

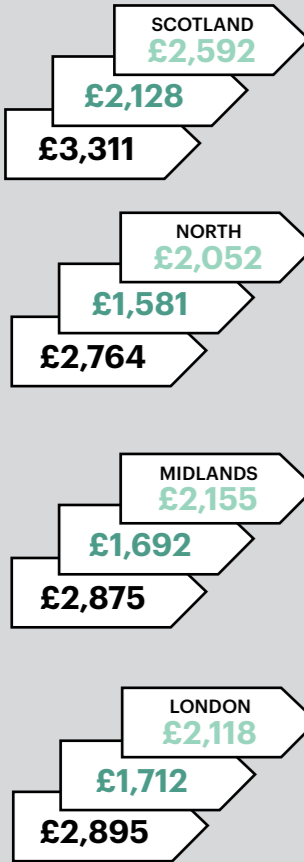

WHICH REGION?

Our analysis showed that Scotland is the most expensive place, on average, for 10 delegates from across the country to get together, when you factor in travel, parking, transfers and then meeting room and accommodation rates. This is mainly due to the travel cost, which for travellers coming from southern locations is obviously likely to involve a flight, rather than rail travel.

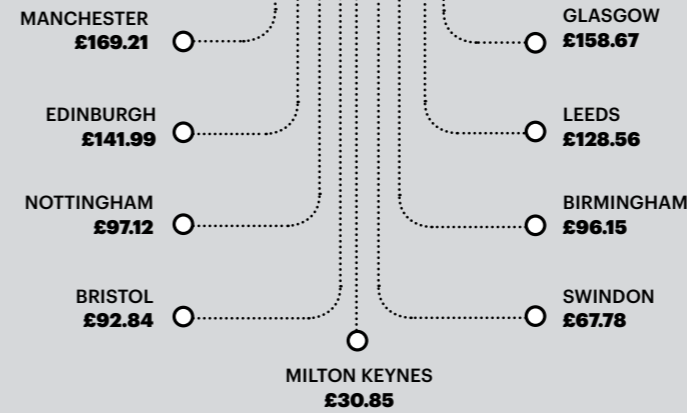


- Total cost of travel, meeting and overnight stay for 10 delegates
